Once upon a time a family in Haute-Savoie (France), the Felisaz. In 1986, Henri created FELISAZ SAS, a workshop producing cams for automatic turning machines. In 1994, Jean-Michel and Albert created FELISAZ SAS, a workshop started a diversification.

PLUM is a story of passion. At the end of the 90s, Albert was about to take a step forward. In fact, let's say a step higher. At this time, he wanted to replace this family tradition in his context : the Haute-Savoie, the mountains, the Mont-Blanc.

One door to the workshop, one door to the top

With PLUM, it's quite simple. A door was already open between the research unit and the workshop. Open since the beginnings of the Felisaz's company, 47 years ago. Albert assures : we just opened the door to the mountains. So people always ask Albert : why starting a ski gear business ? First, because some people asked us to do it. In 2005, the Chablais Alpine Club consulted us to design an ultra-light heel.

Then because here, in the heart of the French Alps, it was quite obvious. We had an expertise in turning and precision mechanics. We were already skiers, snowboarders. The determination of the entire team did the rest : in 2005 PLUM was born. 10 years later, the company is still growing.

Our vision ? Ski and splitboard bindings designed for you with passion. Designed and made in our workshop. Our ambition ? Produce efficient, resistant and ultra-light bindings. Products in which we trust. Products we are proud of. 100% homemade.

This year PLUM celebrates his 10th birthday. 10 years of pleasure skiing the most wonderful summits of the planet. 10 years on the steeper slopes. 10 years providing the best athletes in ski-mountaineering races. 10 years with you on snow or in our workshop in Thyez (Haute-Savoie). 10 years that's not too bad, but we are not going to stop here. In 2011 the YAK made its appearance : for all freeriders. The YAK is the binding with inserts that is closest to alpine skiing sensations.

For our 10 years anniversary, we designed the RACE 99, one of the lightest ski mountaineering bindings on the market. 2015 is also the year of the WEPA, which finds its place between the ranges RACE and GUIDE. A new concept that combines lightness and precision for those who think outside the box.

What will be our next innovation? One thing remains certain : PLUM will still amaze you.

Made of high performance materials (Alu 7075 T6 Titanium ...), the RACE combines lightness and strength. New in 2015: with our new system, it will be easier to put on your skis, when the clock plays against you. As a result, the RACE offers serenity even if you have only a few grams under the foot.

Looking for high mountain in the Himalayas, for ascent velocity in competitions or for ski adventures here and abroad ? The PLUM RACE will help you keep smiling when the thighs are screaming to stop everything.

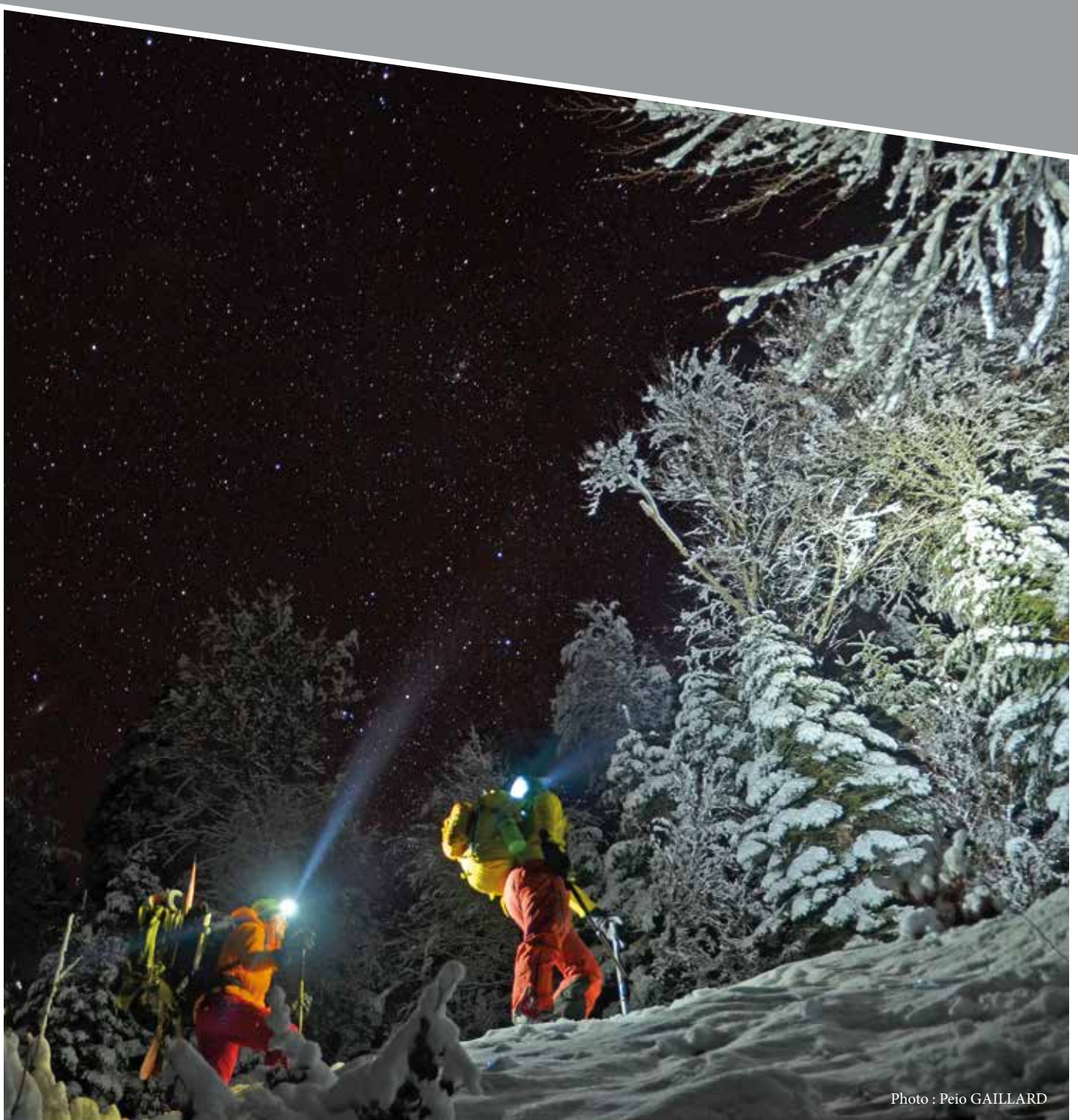

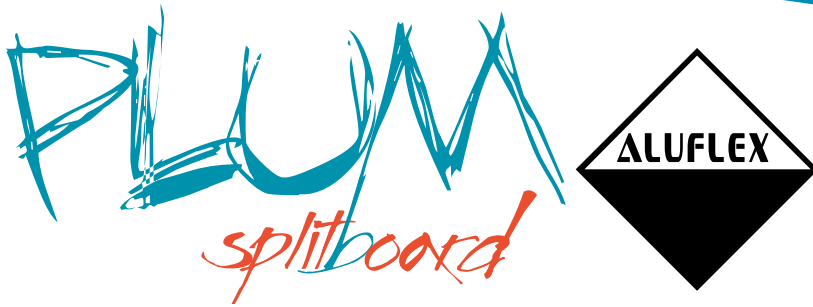

Not far away to PLUM company, the Aluflex workshop is an unusual place. Thanks to passion and knowledge, Daniel and Piero are shaping the perfect boards.

Since the last 30 years, the Aluflex company design and manufacture high premium skis and snowboards. With them, we made the choice of a big radius for a better precision on snow and a better versatility.

The two PLUM models – TALPS and PREMS – have a slightly rocker which provides all the lightness needed in touring sessions.

The result, you will ride with a manoeuvrable and playfull board

Technical features

- Sandwich construction fiberglass/wood
- Quad-axial fiberglass (strength and energy return)
- Wood core paulownia-ash (ash for its compressive strength, paulownia for its lightness)

The PREMS has a specific shape developed to the splitboard practice and his constraints.
